- Apart from spellings, I do not feel as though I know how well they are doing
- 20) Is there anything else you would want school to do better?
 - 29 forms made no comments and thanked the school for all they do.
 - I would like to know more such as who my child has played with, if he was eating and if he had to be changed.
 - Give the education that all pupils need and not just some. Treat all children fairly instead of giving some pupils rewards and privileges than others even if they have been less well behaved than others.
 - I would like to know about what my child is learning/doing or if there are any incidents.
 - Reply to emails better
 - A more flexible breakfast club on an ad hoc basis and pay when needed to allow better access for working parents when they need it.

- More communication between teachers and parents around SATS tests.
- Communication to be improved
- Introduce class dojo so that there is a way of keeping in touch with the class teacher so I could ask questions and send information direct to the teacher.
- Sometimes the kids who are doing well don't get enough recognition. Some parents get well done texts and others don't
- Have stuff on the food menu that children actually eat. I'm entitled to FSM but I have to make a packed lunch everyday as my child will only eat child friendly food.
- Improve discipline
- Poor first aid
- Inform parents when issues happen once there was an issue where you wouldn't let us take our children and didn't inform us what had happened.
- School should give more notice about upcoming events to give parents more time to prepare
- Re-consider changing the PE kit as a white T-shirts is not lasting on PE days or reconsider changing into PE Kits on PE days.
- Teachers not being able to control certain children needs addressing please.
- We need to get back the really good parent teacher relationship that we had pre-covid. I think that has changed a lot sadly.
- It would be nice to receive more messages about wow moments.
- Although parents were consulted on the proposal for September, they were not consulted when other changes happened at other times through the year.
- More rewards for children aside from star of the week when they get 10/10 for spellings or improved something they are struggling with.
