Attendance

At Meadow View Primary School we expect all pupils to have good attendance, which is **96% or better**. The attendance team work hard to monitor children's attendance, offer support and ensure parents are kept up to date with their child's attendance.

Each week each class in Y1-Y6 competes in an 'Attendance Race'. The winning class is the class that has the highest attendance percentage. This class is rewarded with an additional playtime during school time. The feedback from children is great and children tell us that they love this competition.

In addition to the attendance race we have a raffle. Any children, who on the last day of term has an attendance figure above 96% will be entered into the raffle. Winners will be picked out at random on the last day of school before the summer holidays. The first prize will be £50 of Meadowhall vouchers and there will be 4 runner up prizes of f10 Meadowhall vouchers

Any children who attain 100% attendance will clapped and cheered in assembly and they will receive a prize.

Over the year you will receive letters to inform you of where your child's attendance is so that you are aware whether your child will be entered into the raffle.

Good attendance habits pay off! More school days attended increases a child's academic success and improves their life chances. We believe that every child can succeed and want the best for all of our pupils.
