School Uniform

Thank you to all of our wonderful parents who have helped support the school by ensuring that all children are dressed in the correct uniform and PE Kit. As a school, we are hoping to start up a uniform recycling service which will be led by Mrs Morgan. If you have any old uniform you can donate, please bring it into school. If you are struggling financially and would like to receive some second hand uniform. Please have a quiet word with Mrs Morgan. This can be done on the gate in a morning or by phoning or emailing school.

COVID-19

If your child has any symptoms (cough, temperature or loss of taste/smell) you must not bring them to school and must seek a PCR test.

If children develop any of these symptoms whilst at school, parents will be asked to collect their child and arrange a PCR test.

If we have a positive case of covid-19 in school, it will be parental responsibility to report the case to Public Health England and to inform them of any close contacts that your child has been with in school.

If you have a positive case in your household, the children can still come to school. Public Health England should be advising a PCR test for any close contacts including children.

Anyone who tests positive should isolate and therefore cannot come onto school grounds. If you have difficulty getting your children to school, please let school know.

INSET DAYS

INSET stands for In-Service Training Day. These are 5 identified days across the year that are used for staff development. Children do not attend school on INSET Days. Our INSET days this year are:
