### Sports Days

In Key Stage 1 and 2, we organise our sports days so that the children participate in a variety of sports for the whole afternoon, however Parents and Carers are invited to come and watch the races section of the day. The dates for our sports days are as follows:

EYFS (F0, F1 and F2) Friday 13<sup>th</sup> June at 10:45am-11:30

Key Stage 1 (Y1 and Y2) Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> June at 2pm

Key Stage 2 (Y3, Y4, Y5 & Y6) Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June at 2pm

On the day of your child's sports day, they should attend school wearing trainers, black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms with a t-shirt in their house colour.

Parents and Carers will be welcomed through the exit gate 5 minutes before the races start. For safety reasons, children will stay with their teachers and will not be allowed to go to their parents or carers during the event.

**Y1 and Y2 resit Phonic tests** will take place the week beginning 9<sup>th</sup> June.
